



Articulation Agreement

Between Southern Bible Institute & College - Associate of Arts Degree and Parker University Health Science Programs

- Graduates of the SBIC program who have 1) completed the Associate of Arts in General Studies degree with Health Science concentration, 2) a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.50 or better, and 3) meet the published admission requirements of the Health Science programs at Parker University will automatically be accepted into the university's Associate of Arts or Baccalaureate programs.
 - Those with a GPA of less than 2.50 may be offered remediated courses to improve their GPA.
 - Students transferring from SBIC may transfer credits, up to a maximum of 48 credit hours toward their Associate of Applied Science degree and a maximum of 92 for their Baccalaureate degree.
 - Students must complete a minimum of 33 credit hours at SBIC to be eligible for an Associate of Applied Science degree or a minimum of 66 credit hours for a Bachelor of Science in a Health Sciences program.
 - Students intending to transfer should complete the admissions process for Parker University, following the second semester of their associate degree program.
